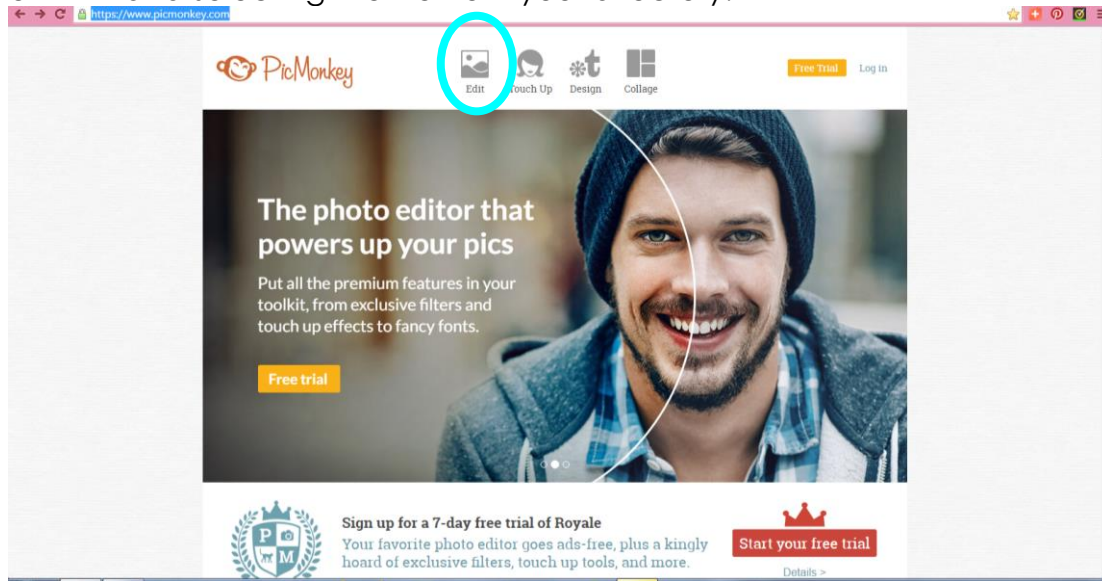
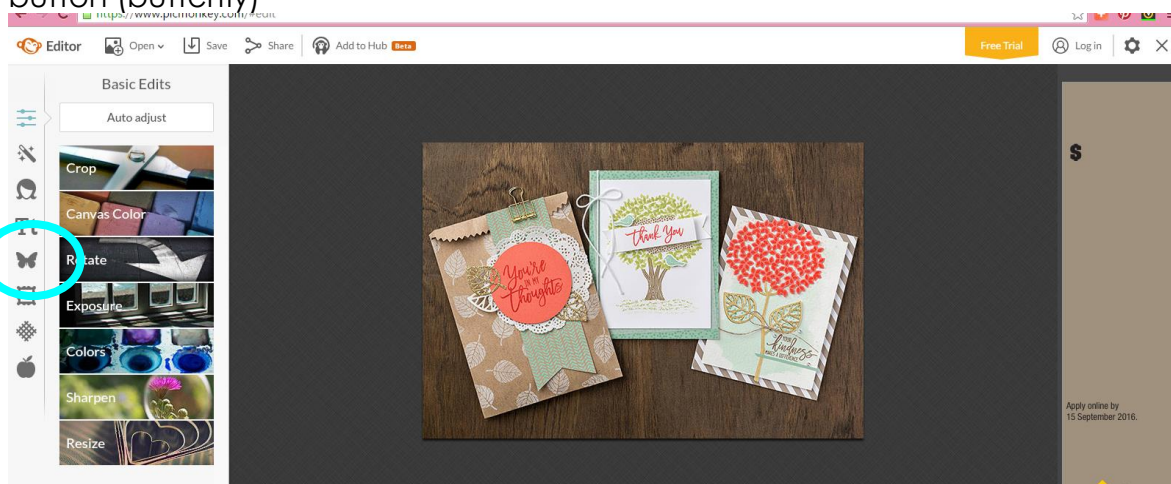


Adding a watermark using PicMonkey

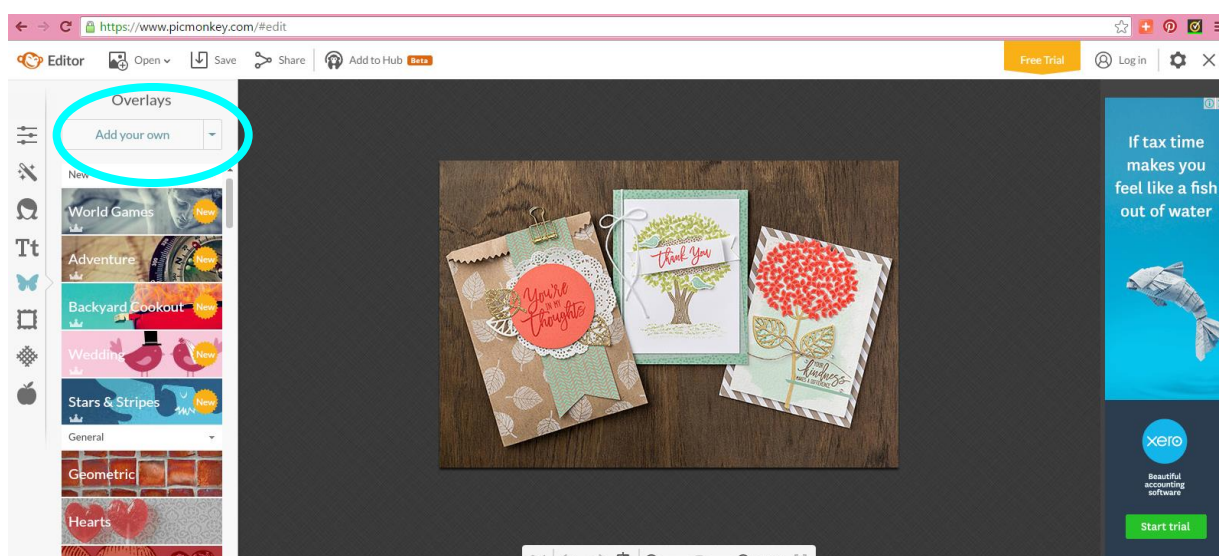
I have a watermark tutorial for you today and I want to show you how to layer a watermark on top of a photo using a free program called PicMonkey. This program works in your internet browser on your computer and you can access it at <https://www.picmonkey.com/>. When you open PicMonkey, this is what it looks like. First, you'll need to open your photograph by clicking on EDIT and selecting the file from your directory.



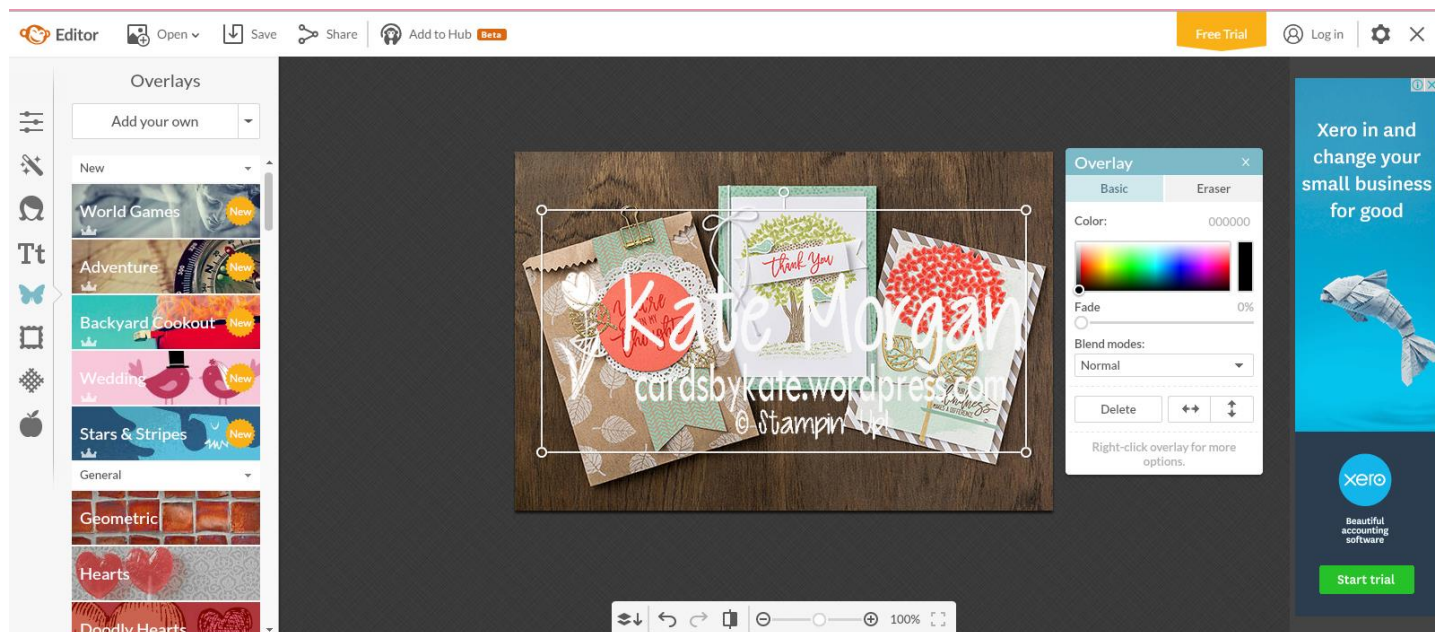
Now you have your photograph open, you want to add your watermark. Click on the **Overlay** button (butterfly)



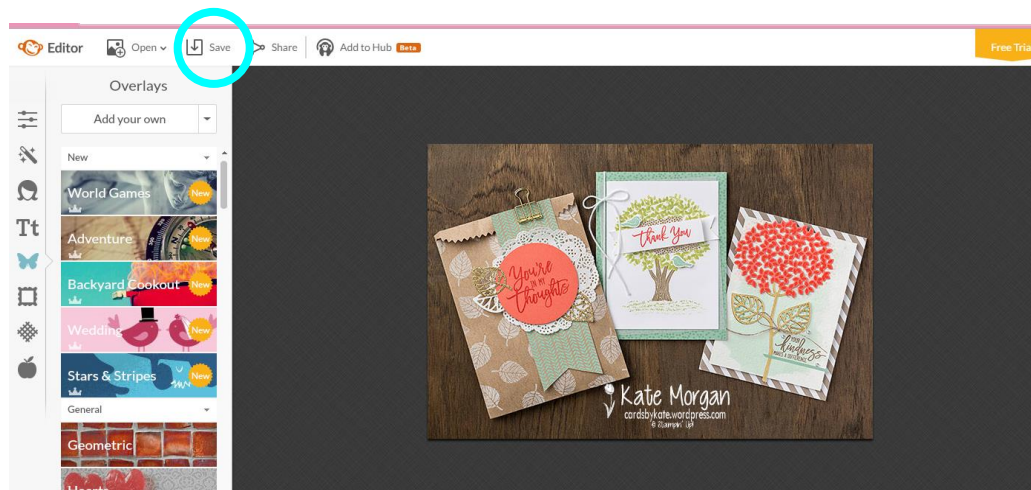
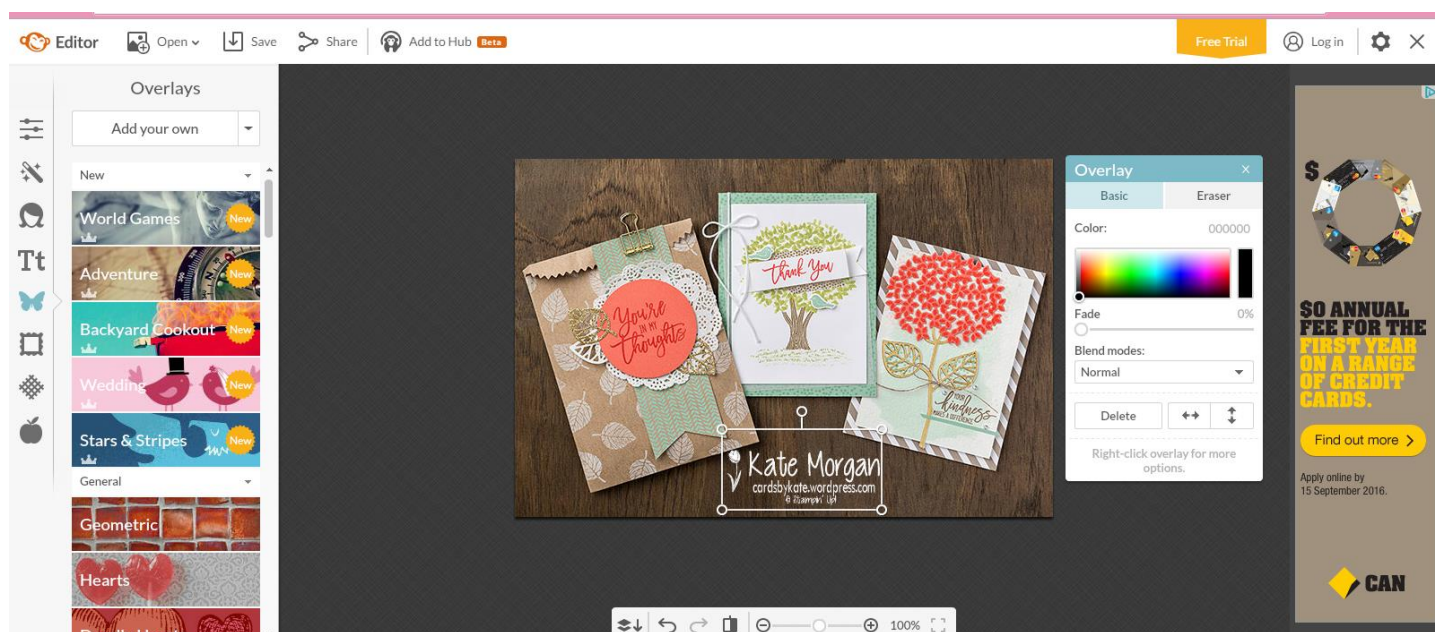
Now click on **Add your Own** and select your watermark from your computer



The watermark will now be in the centre of your photo and may look too big but don't stress.



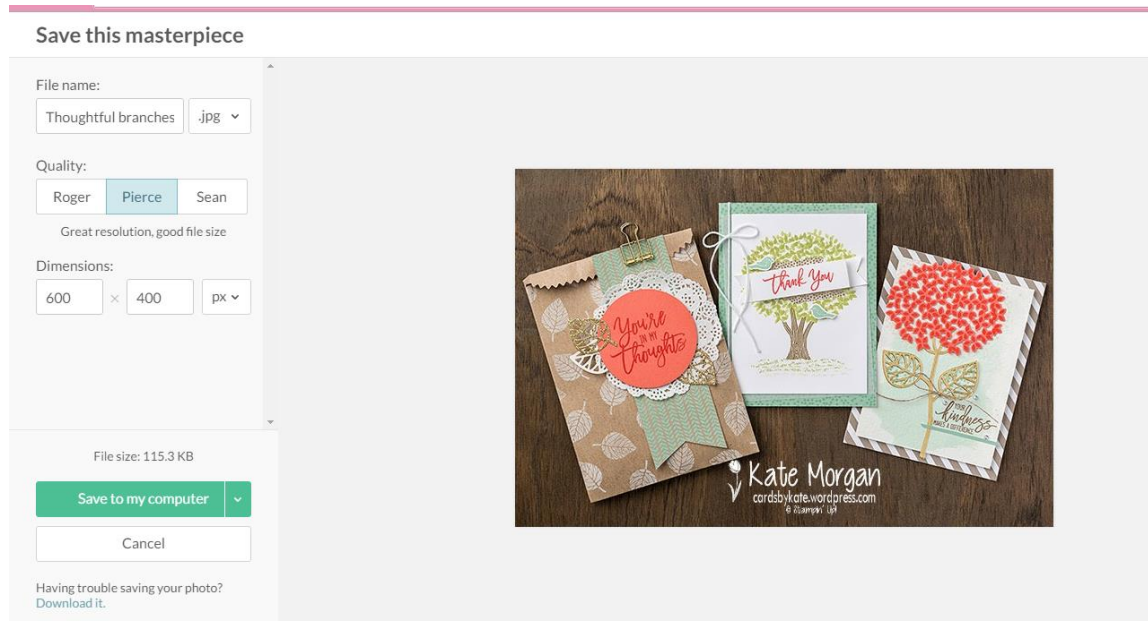
To resize the watermark, click on one of the corners, hold and drag to make it the size you require. Then to reposition your watermark, click in the centre of the watermark, hold and move it to where you would like it placed on your photograph.



Click off the photo to see your finished project.

Now you can click on **Save**

You change the file name if you don't want to save over the original photograph, then **Save to my Computer**.
