

# Explosion Box Card

Supplies:

1 sheet A4 Cardstock  
Coordinating DSP  
Stampin' Trimmer  
Adhesive (Tombo glue or sticky strip)  
Stamps (Flower Shop & Papillon Butterfly used here)  
Acetate, cut into narrow strips (optional)

Step 1:

Cut cardstock to 29.7 x 13cm.  
Score at 7cm.



Rotate cardstock so the 7cm section is at the top of the trimmer.

**Ensure that you have the scoring blade at the top and the cutting blade at the bottom of the cardstock before starting.**

At 7cm, score the length of the cardstock. Before moving it, use the cutting blade (bottom) cut up to the 7cm score line. It is much easier to line up once, score and cut before moving the card to the next step.

Repeat this process at 14cm, 21cm, 28cm



Cut the smallest section out.

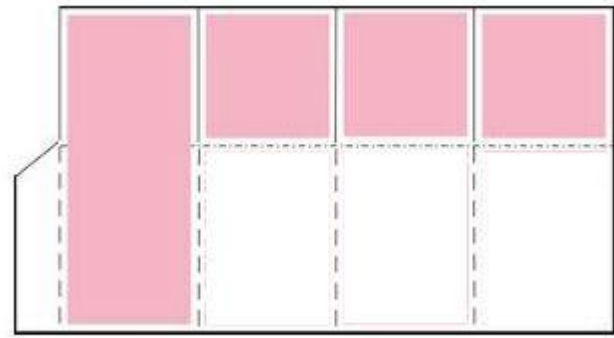
Fold on the score lines, but ensure you DO NOT fold the last panel (see picture right) as this is a full panel for your message.



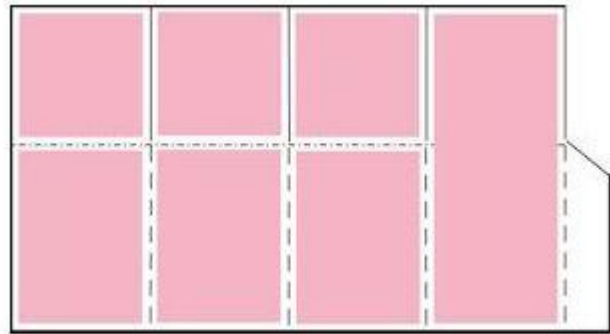
**Note** (it is easier to decorate before closing together with adhesive on the smallest panel).

Cut DSP to decorate each panel as follows:

1. inside back panel, 12.5 x 6.5cm
2. upper panels x3, 5.5 x 6.5cm
3. upper panels x3, 5.5 x 6.5cm
4. lower panels x3 (outside only), 6.5 x 6.5cm
5. outside back panel, 12.5 x 6.5cm (White cardstock to be able to write your message)

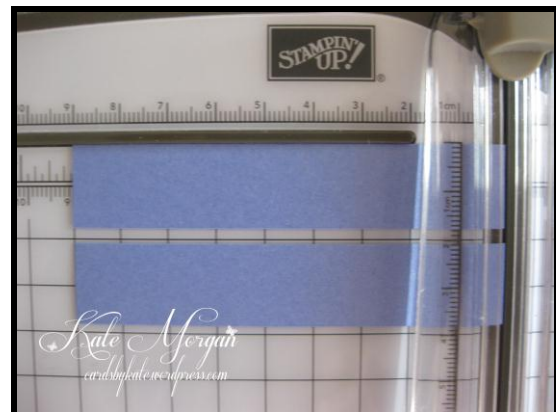


**INSIDE OF BOX**

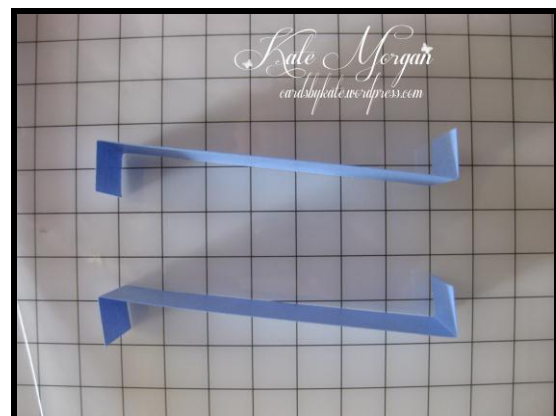


**OUTSIDE OF BOX**

Cut 2 strips, 1.5cm x 9cm  
Score each strip at 1cm from each end.



Fold ends in opposite directions.



Adhere the box together.



Add adhesive to ends and insert into the box so they line up with the top of the box.

Try and have the sections in equal thirds.



Decorate as desired.
