

Gift Purse

1. Cut an A4 sheet of [Pear Pizzazz cardstock](#) in half down the long edge with [Trimmer](#) so it measures 8¼" x 5⅞".
2. Cut a piece of [Floral Romance SDSP](#) to 8" x 5½".
3. Using the [Envelope Punch Board](#), round two of the corners at one end of the card and the same on the DSP.
4. Glue the DSP to the card stock.
5. Place this on your [Simply Scored](#), DSP side down and rounded corners to the right-hand side.
6. Score at 3", 3⅜", 6½", 6⅝", 6¾", 6⅞". Fold the first two score lines carefully with your fingers (don't use a bone folder as it's too harsh). The four score lines that are close together, place the handle of a wooden spoon against them and gently roll to get that nice gentle curve of the top flap.
7. Cut two pieces of card measuring 3" x 2⅞".
8. 3" side to top of Simply Scored, score each piece every ⅜" @ ⅜", ¾", 1⅛", 1½", 1⅞", 2¼", 2⅝".
9. Fold each one into a concertina fold.
10. Place [Tear & Tape](#) on each end.
11. Remove the cover from one end of the Tear & Tape at a time while you adhere these into the inside of the purse, centering them between the score lines (see pic).
12. Cut a strip of card 1" x 8¼" and score down the length at ⅛" on both sides. This gives a nice border. Fold it around the centre of the purse and glue the ends together at the front. Just be careful it's not too tight that you can't slide it off the purse.
13. Cut a strip of vellum ⅝" x 7½" and glue it in the centre.
14. Using [Big Shot](#), die cut a small [scallop square](#) of card and glue to the centre, over the join of the belly band. I cut a 1" x 1" square of DSP to place in the centre and then added a [wax seal](#) to finish it off.
15. Add some cash notes for the recipient!!!
