

FLIP AND POP UP CARD

Products:

Stamp Bundle: Hello Ladybug stamp set and Ladybug Builder Punch

Dies: Layering Circles Framelits

Card/Paper: Thick Basic White, Basic White, Magenta Madness, Abstract Beauty 4" x 6" DSP

Inks: Magenta Madness & Memento Black

Other: Wink of Stella, Dimensionals, Multipurpose Glue, Trimmer, Cut & Emboss Machine, Shammy, Stamparatus, Basic Rhinestone Jewels, Paper Snips

Measurements:

Thick Basic White card base 10.5cm x 28 scored at 14cm

Patterned Paper: 10cm x 13.5cm

Magenta Madness circle 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " (largest in the set)

Basic White scalloped circle 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ " (2nd largest in the set)

Basic White 11.5cm x 5cm strip, scored at 2.5cm, 5cm, 7.5cm, 10cm for the flip box

Basic White 5cm x 2cm strip folded in half for the flip mechanism



1. Score card base in half and burnish.
2. Adhere the patterned paper to the card front, leaving an even border around the edge.
3. Open the card and place the 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " circle approximately 1.5cm from the top of the card ensuring it is centred and die cut.
4. Stamp the flowers 4 times in Magenta Madness ink onto the white scalloped 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ " circle.
5. Stamp the ladybug body in Memento Black ink (use the Stamparatus to ensure it is nice and dark) and the wings in Magenta Madness then punch them out using the Ladybug Builder Punch.
6. Fold the Basic White strip for the Flip box and glue the smallest tab inside to create a box.
7. Add glue to one side only and place it inside of the card, at the top (centred). Close the card so it sits nicely and hold until dry/set. Don't worry that you can see it through the die cut circle on the front.
8. Open the card again and place glue on the back of the card front where the box will join it (don't put glue on the box).
9. Glue the folded mechanism as shown and close the card for the glue to set.
10. Place glue only on the mechanism from the front of the card and place the Magenta Madness circle on so it sits in the die cut space from the front of the card.
11. Glue the stamped white scalloped circle to the Magenta Madness circle.
12. Glue the wings of the ladybug to the body, then add Dimensionals to the back and adhere to the circle feature.
13. Add Wink of Stella to the wings and some gems/rhinestones to the centres of each of the flowers.
14. Stamp the sentiment on a piece of scrap white card. The left over piece from the DSP was flipped over and used behind the sentiment.
15. Stamp more flowers on the inside and another sentiment if you wish.
